

Springburn Health Centre Glasgow

The existing Health Centre has undergone a multi-phase extension and refurbishment over the course of three years, to provide expanded GP and support services, improved public access and relocation of the Pharmacy.

Security was an important consideration, and robust finishes with discreet security measures were necessary. The extension sits on 'legs' due to the southward sloping site, and has been clad in timber to reduce weight and give a more friendly face to the Centre.

Internal courtyards, previously abandoned to concrete paving, have been given new purpose providing additional accommodation and a new staircase, allowing increased patient waiting areas and improved, less institutional circulation.

A new entrance arrangement gives focus to the public access.

The project was undertaken in three consecutive main contracts, the latter of which required multiple phasing to allow the Centre to continue service as normal.
