Haddington Town House is a Grade B Listed Building occupying a prime position on the main street of the town. The Town House and steeple were in general disrepair with badly spalling stonework, which posed a safety risk.

The project, under grant aid from Historic Scotland, is for the repairs to the steeple, and includes stonework repointing and indenting, repair of clock faces and floodlighting, as well as provision of protective leadwork and bird deterrents to ledges. The opportunity was taken to stabilise the weathervane finial which was corroded, and restore it using goldleaf.
